## **Partnership Highlights**

Innovation is the proud title sponsor of the BGC Saskatoon Innovation Mini Clubs Grub Club and Big Brothers Big Sisters Battlefords Innovation Indigenous Arts Partnership Project.

**Innovation Grub Club** provides children and youth in Mini Club programs with healthy snacks before and after school. BGC Mini Clubs also respond to the individual needs of the communities surrounding the school they are located in. This program needed funding to ensure food security for their participants.



### Indigenous Arts Partnership Project (IAPP)

The Innovation CU Indigenous Arts Partnership Project (IAPP) of The Battlefords is a community youth program where Indigenous friends and neighbours can learn more about Indigenous art, culture, language, and history in small group activity settings. A team of supportive adult allies provide mentorship, guidance, and reflection. While local instructors, Knowledge Keepers, and Elders deliver teachings.

IAPPs objective is to provide:

- Opportunities to help keep First Nations culture alive within youth, a positive experience,
- Bond in learning culture and art that has been lost among family units, and
- An immersive experience to further Reconciliation efforts in the community at large.

Innovation's investment in the IAPP in 2022 allowed the program to expand its programming, buy more supplies, and offer new opportunities and support to youth in the community. It also made more individualized youth support possible.

In the summer of 2022, youth and adult allies from the IAPP created a dreamcatcher as a gift for Innovation's generosity. It serves as a symbol of wahkohtowin (community | kinship | connection) and thanks.
